

2007 Scrip Quick Guide

eScrip

1. Go to eScrip.com website and register cards: Safeway, debit and credit cards, Macy's card. Call 1-877-SAFEWAY if you don't have your Safeway card number. Use group ID # 137315320, or you can search by zip code to find Gold Trail Parent Teacher Group online.
2. Every time any of these cards are used at a participating merchant, a portion of the sale goes to our Scrip account.
3. Shop at the online mall at <http://www.escrip.com>. Must use a registered card and the school gets a percentage of every purchase. Hundreds of merchants – Huge selection!
4. You can sign up friends and family from all over the country. All Safeway stores participate and in 2007, we received donations from 26 stores throughout the country. Periodic Safeway promotions such as "Back to School" allow for greater earning potential.

Raley's and Bel Air Quality of Life Card

1. Get a Quality of Life Card. Scrip chair must record the card number to keep track of individuals.
2. Card recipient must register the new card at <http://www.raleys.com>. Click on *Neighborhood*, then *Quality of Life Card*, and *Click Here to Activate your Card*. Cards are then pre-registered to donate to GTUSD, but still be be "activated" to initialize.

BoxTops4Education.com

1. Go to site directly, or link through <http://www.gtusd.org>. You must register with the site, but you do not need to use a registered card.
2. Shop at hundreds of online sites and our school gets a percentage of every purchase.
3. Clip "box tops" from tops of cereal boxes and other products. Collect and return these to the school. These are worth 10 cents each. Heidi Miller is in charge of this program.

Amazon.com

1. Link to Amazon.com through the <http://www.gtusd.org> site and PTO receives 10% of purchases made.
2. You don't need to use a registered card to get benefits – all sales through our web site earn a commission. The program is called Amazon Associates.

Food 4 Less

1. Use Scrip card and we receive 3% of the total. Get a card from Julie Bauer and fill out the attached application. Give the application to the cashier BEFORE your order is totaled. You must pre-load the card with money before it can be used (similar to a gift card), then add money each time you shop, remembering to tell the clerk before your order is completed.
2. Collect receipts. Turn them in to Julie Bauer or deposit in the envelope in the offices and they can be redeemed for an additional 1% donation.
3. Program includes the new Nugget Market in EDH and Food4Less in Cameron Park.
