

Scenario Three - In a School or Cohort Setting

No action is needed

Yes, I currently am experiencing (or have experienced in the past 14 days) one or more of the symptoms of COVID-19 above, that are new to me, and that I can confirm are not related to any ongoing condition that I have previously or regularly experienced (i.e., seasonal allergies, migraines, sore throat, chronic mild chest congestion associated with common cold, etc.)

Symptom Screening Prior to Entry

As required by the County Health Officer



Yes, I am currently taking a medication (prescription or over-the-counter) that that may mask or disguise the symptoms of COVID-19?

No, I am not currently taking any medication (prescription or over-the-counter) that that I am aware may mask or disguise the symptoms of COVID-19?

Yes, someone in my household, or someone I have come in close contact with

(within 6 feet for 15 minutes or more), is ill or presenting the symptoms of COVID-

No, nobody in in my household, or that I have come in close contact with (within 6 feet for 15 minutes or more), is ill or presenting the symptoms of COVID-19 above.

Wait until at least 24 hours have passed since recovery, defined as resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications, AND improvement in other symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath), AND at least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared.

And according to the Centers for Disease Control (CDC)

"Everyone, including staff, parents and students is required to handle symptom screening prior to arriving on campus each day. Your presence on campus is an indication that you have screened yourself for symptoms per the symptom screening questions included in this plan. Please follow





Mask Requirements

Gaiters and Face Shields not allowed at this time.

(Face shields allowed WITH DRAPE)



Evaluation is on-going but effectiveness is unknown at this time

DO NOT choose masks that



Are made of fabric that makes it hard to breathe, for example, vinyl



Have exhalation valves or vents, which allow virus particles to escape



Are intended for healthcare workers, including N95 respirators or surgical masks

DO choose masks that



Have two or more layers of washable, breathable fabric



Completely cover your nose and mouth



Fit snugly against the sides of your face and don't have gaps

Grades K - 2: Masks are Strongly Recommended Grades 3 - 8: Masks are REQUIRED.



GTUSD General Safety Measures

SICK STUDENT GUIDANCE DOCUMENT

The health and safety of our students are important.



COVID-19 like signs and symptoms that start this process

If a student exhibits any one of the following symptoms, start the sick student process listed below:

- Fever (temperature over 100.4° F or 38° C) without having taken any fever-reducing medications
- · Loss of smell or taste
- · Cough
- Muscle aches
- · Sore throat
- Shortness of breath
- Chills
- · New or unusual headache
- 1. Place a face mask on the student (if they will tolerate it)
- 2. Separate the student from the rest of the class
- 3. Have a staff member walk the student to a designated sick area at the site to isolate student
- 4. Contact parents to request their student be picked up
- 5. Contact your site administrator to make them aware
- 6. Your site administrator will contact the school nurse


















What will the Hybrid Schedule Look like?
